Dear Elders and Families,

Sherbrooke has no cases of Covid-19 but it is with sadness that we share with you that the Saskatchewan Health Authority has moved Saskatoon to Level 2 Family Presence restrictions due to an increase in Covid-19 activity in our city. Only compassionate care visits are allowed at this time. This means that at Sherbrooke, we will be stopping all designated visitor indoor visits, and all supportive care visits for at least the next two weeks. We are also stopping all outdoor visits.
