One resident of Sherbrooke Community Centre has tested positive for COVID-19. This places Sherbrooke in suspect Covid-19 outbreak. Management at Sherbrooke are working closely with the Saskatchewan Health Authority and Public Health officials to identify anyone who may have been exposed and is taking steps to protect the health of all residents, staff and families. Outbreak control measures have been implemented and families of all residents have been notified.

Sherbrooke Community Centre CEO, Suellen Beatty, says, “Sherbrooke was proactive in implementing infection control and screening protocols since the first days of the pandemic. We continue to work closely with public health authorities to ensure our response will keep our residents and staff safe and move Sherbrooke into recovery.”

Beatty added, “we are taking every precaution necessary to ensure the virus is contained, with the health and safety of our residents and staff remaining our top priority.”
