Dear Residents and Families,

Thank you for your cooperation and support as we safely work to bring back a sense of normalcy to our community. It has been wonderful seeing so many residents visiting outdoors with families and friends, and we have registered more than 1000 indoor visitors. Your presence has certainly invigorated our building!

Step Two of Saskatchewan's Three Step Re-opening Plan begins on Sunday, June 20th. This happens to be Father's Day and we know it will be a busy day for visiting. Starting on Sunday, June 20th, all residents (those who are fully vaccinated and those who are not) will be able to have:

- Four visitors at a time indoors;
- Nine visitors at a time outdoors, and
- Outings in the community (residents who leave must follow all public health orders while out).

Please note that these numbers may be limited by the capacity of the space and the ability to follow the physical distancing requirements as per the current public health order. For example, there is not space for four visitors to be in a resident's room and maintain the physical distancing requirements unless those family members are all from the same household.

We are expecting new indoor visitors this Sunday which is why we wanted to remind you of our indoor visiting guidelines. **Please share this information with your friends and family members.**

Prior to visiting a resident at Sherbrooke, each visitor:

- Must sign an indoor visiting contract;
- Must complete a screening questionnaire, and
- Must watch an educational video.

Please bring your completed indoor visiting contract and screening questionnaire with you on your first visit. **If the above criteria are met and you pass screening, you will**

be able to visit. If you have not completed the requirements you will be turned away until the requirements have been met.

A reminder that all visitors are required to:

- Complete health screening before entering the home.
- Wash your hands/use hand sanitizer.
- Wear a mask at all times (must cover your nose, mouth and chin – don't lower it to talk!).
- Not eat or drink while visiting.
- Keep a 2m (6ft) distance between yourself and others (except those from the same household).
- Follow all Public Health Orders.
- Children can visit if supervised by a pre-approved family/support person.

We are grateful for your support as we continue to safely follow Saskatchewan's Three Step Re-opening plan here at Sherbrooke. Father's Day is a special time for many families and residents and we hope all of this information will help make your visit as meaningful as possible.
